Public transport is used including buses, underground and train. Participants must be able to wheel their own luggage and take it up steps. A carry-on roller bag is strongly suggested as the only bag.





## Daily Overview

- **Day One** – Depart from the USA
- **Day Two** – Arrive in Edinburgh: Walking Tour of Covenanter and Reformation Old Town, Greyfriars, Grass Market, Scottish Museum. Guide: Dr Schlichting
- **Day Three** – Worship St Columba's with Dr Chapell, walk Royal Mile including Mercat Cross, St Giles, Knox House and Holyrood. Guide: Dr Carter. Dinner together
- **Day Four** – Visit St. Andrews. Reflect on the lives of Hamilton and Wishart. Guide: Dr. Carter. Lecture: Dr. Chapell
- **Day Five** – Stirling Castle, Martyrs Monuments, Wallace Memorial, Church of the Holy Rude. Lecture: Dr Chapell. Guide: Dr Schlichting Dinner together
- **Day Six** – Train to London, Temple Church, Richard Hooker, Magna Carta, Evensong at St Paul's Guide: Dr. Schlichting
- **Day Seven** – St Paul's, Westminster Abbey, Wesley's Chapel, Guide: Dr Carter. Theatre Night: Les Mis. Quick dinner together
- **Day Eight** - British Museum, National Gallery, Martyrs Walk from Tower Hill to Tyburn (Newton, Cromwell, More, Chalmers etc.) Guide: Dr. Schlichting. Evening Group Dinner w/talk by Dr Chapell
- **Day Nine** – Train to Oxford, University Church, Addison's Walk, C.S. Lewis, Ridley, Lattimer and Cranmer. Guide: Dr. Carter. Lecture: Dr Chapell. Dinner together
- **Day Ten** – Fly Home

**Cost and Deposits = ~\$5,000 per person double occupancy from Atlanta (includes basic economy airfare, hotels with breakfast, in country travel and entrance fees)**
